Through our dedication of this annual, we wish to thank them.

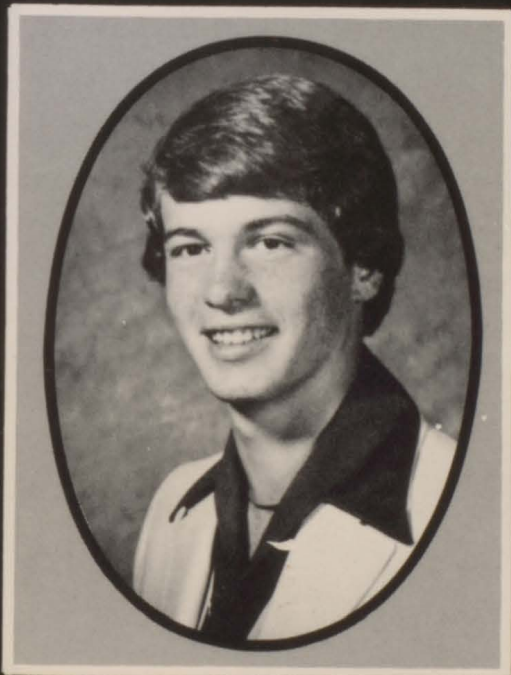
